> It is also a very common word in movies. In fact, how many of us can place this movie quote, "It is your destiny"? (let me give you a hint, say it as if you are gasping for air, on an intergalactic ship...did that help? (3).

> But did you realize that as Believers in Jesus Christ, and as children by adoption, we too have a destiny? Here's how the Apostle Paul captured it in Ephesians 1:5:

"In love, He predestined us for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will "

Paul is not speaking about some dark sithlord declaring his parenthood; he is speaking about someone far more real and powerful: the God of all Creation.

And He is not calling us to partner with him in some galactic control plan (He already owns and controls all things...checkout Hebrews Chapter 1), but He is inviting us into intimate fellowship with Himself ... and then some.

One of my favorite versus, hidden behind another favorite verse of most believers, is Romans 8:29.

It says "For those whom He foreknew He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son."

There are also several online plans (the one we use is on the Ligonier app). Pick one, and let's allow the Word of God to begin transforming our lives and our homes!

It continues with memorizing Scripture.

Our children have been memorizing one passage a month, and we are going to join them! Learning 12 passages a year may not sound like much, but folks, it's a start. Please join us in learning January's verse:

"I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live." John 11:25

And it concludes with learning Catechisms.

Once again, our children have been accomplishing this for over a year; now we get to join them! Each month, as a church, we will work on 3-4 questions a month. Some will ask, why learn catechisms? Parables of Judgment. (4 Weeks)








Chase & Joanna were united in holy matrimony Saturday, January 3, 2015.
