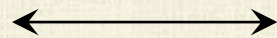

# From the Pastor

Summer's here and I am excited about all that's on the horizon! While I see the "behind the scenes" excitement that is going on as we plan for the future, I am also thoroughly excited about the in depth Bible studies taking place throughout our church.

Everywhere I turn, Scripture is being discussed. Folks are not content with "what they learned years ago," they are digging deeper and finding treasures they had not seen before. And it's all buried deep within God's Word for those who will seek! Now, that's the type of thing that make a pastor beam with excitement!

As we grow together and find new & exciting things (yes, even I am finding new things through the study on elders -- and loving it!), I want some verses in 1 Corinthians to be at the forefront.

**1 Cor 8:1**, "We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge makes arrogant, but **love edifies.**" Another translation states it, "But while knowledge makes us feel important, **it is love that strengthens the church.**"

Folks, let's not miss that. In depth Bible study is good; in fact, I would say it's *mandatory* if we want to have the tools to protect the body of Christ from false teaching. However, while **Bible knowledge protects the body; love will strengthen it.**

If your growth in the Word is not causing you to love Christ and His Bride more, you're missing something very critical.

**1 Cor 13:1-2**, "If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, **I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.** And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, **I am nothing.**"

Let's not miss the importance of love growing within each of us in proportion to our knowledge, for they go hand in hand within those seeking the best for the body of Christ.

Let's also continue to pray for true revival (*renewed attention to or interest in something; restoration of force, validity, or effect*) during this time which should result in us loving the Lord our God (*more & more*) with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. And loving each other (*more & more*) above ourselves.

Folks, if your "Christian walk" doesn't include either of those things, I need to challenge you to reexamine your path. A heart that is cold towards God's Word and/or His people is usually a result of a heart that is cold towards God, Himself.

I cannot emphasize enough --- TOBC is approaching a cross roads. I hope you are making a deliberate choice to join us for the journey, not just for the vote.
